

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY FOR **GIRLS IN GRADES 7 & 8**

Unless specified as “NOT ALLOWED”, the items listed below may be worn as part of the school uniform. Careful adherence is expected. Demerits will result when these policies are not followed.

- Navy blue or khaki* pants. (Cargo type pants, including pants with outside pockets, are allowed. However, pants must be plain; no racing stripes down the leg. Pants must be straight-legged. Pants must be of corduroy or cotton/twill material.)
- Navy blue or khaki* Capri pants. Capri pants must cover the knee.
- Navy blue or khaki* shorts. May be worn during the months of August, September, October, April, May and June.
- **LENGTH OF SHORTS: Must be knee length, which means to the top of the knee cap. Nothing shorter is allowed.**
- NOT ALLOWED: knits, sweatpants, denim, spandex or leggings.
- * **Navy blue and Khaki material swatches are available in the school office. Be sure any pants or shorts that are worn as part of the uniform match with the swatch.**
- NOT ALLOWED: Decorative belts including scarves.

- Hamilton plaid skirts.
- **LENGTH OF SKIRTS: Must be knee length, which means to the top of the knee cap. Nothing shorter is allowed.**

- White collared polo shirt with two or three buttons, long or short sleeved. Shirt may either be plain with NO logo or with SA logo. (Logo shirt available through Lands End and Shirt Works.)
- Red and Navy blue collared polo shirt with SA logo. (Available through Lands End and Shirt Works.)
- White oxford shirt, long or short sleeved. Shirt may either be plain with NO logo or with SA logo. (Logo shirt available through Lands End and Shirt Works.)
- White turtle neck or mock turtle neck shirt, long or short sleeved.
- BE SURE THAT SHIRTS ARE LONG ENOUGH TO BE TUCKED IN. SHIRTS ARE TO BE TUCKED IN ALL DAY.
- NOT ALLOWED: cap sleeves or logos of any kind on tops unless the SA logo shirts are purchased.
- NOT ALLOWED: Shirts like Aeropostales. For the purpose of our uniform code, camisoles are considered undergarments. Therefore, camisoles, if worn, may not be visible.

- ALLOWED: Plain navy blue, red or white sweaters or sweater vests may be worn over the uniform shirt.
- ALLOWED: St. Anne's navy blue or red sweatshirts may be worn over the uniform shirt.
- NOT ALLOWED: sweater or sweatshirt hoodies.
- NOT ALLOWED: anything made of fleece or sweatshirt material.
- NOT ALLOWED: sweaters or sweatshirts worn around the waist.

- ALLOWED: Tennis shoes with shoe laces or Velcro for every day wear. Shoes with laces must be tied. (NOTE: Besides a pair of shoes for everyday wear, each 7th grader must have a pair of tennis shoes with non-skid soles which are to be reserved **ONLY** for P.E. class.)
- NOT ALLOWED: Crocs, flip-flops, Heelies/Wheelies, or slipper type footwear.
- Socks **must** be worn. They must be red, white or navy blue.
- Tights may be worn. They must be white, red or navy blue.
- NOT ALLOWED: Hats, caps, or scarves.

- ALLOWED: A single fine chain with a small cross or small religious medal or small charm.
- NOT ALLOWED: beads, heavy chains worn as necklaces; dog collars.
- NOT ALLOWED: long and/or oversized earrings.

Red and Navy blue SA logo shirts are available through Lands End and Shirt Works. No other red or navy blue shirts are allowed. White SA logo shirts are available through Lands End and Shirt Works.
White shirts without the logo may be purchased anywhere.
Hamilton Plaid clothes are only available through Dennis House of Uniforms.
