SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICIES

Students in Grades 1-8 are expected to be in the proper uniform every day. Everyone is expected to follow the school uniform policies. It is primarily the responsibility of the parents to see that children come to school dressed in the appropriate uniform. Students who are not in proper uniform and do not have a note will be sent to the principal/assistant principal. **Demerits will result for students in Grades 4-6 when these policies are not followed.**

Some days will be designated as out-of-uniform days; some will be dress-up days, some will have a specific theme, and some will be “free” dress. (Every Friday is an out-of-uniform day for students in Grades 7 & 8 who did not earn a demerit for the week.) Everyone is expected to follow the school policies for out-of-uniform days. On out-of-uniform days, it is also the responsibility of the parents to see that their children are dressed in accordance with the policies. Students who do not follow the out-of-uniform policies and do not come to school in uniform will be sent to the principal/assistant principal.

Students may use only ONE out-of-uniform pass in one school week. All students with an out-of-uniform pass must bring it to the office BEFORE the start of the school day. Homeroom teachers are responsible to keep track of the number of out-of-uniform passes used by each student.

- White SA logo shirts are available through Lands’ End and Shirt Works.
- White shirts without the logo may be purchased anywhere.
- Red and navy blue SA logo shirts are available through Lands’ End and Shirt Works.
- No other red or navy blue shirts are allowed.
- Hamilton Plaid clothes are available through Dennis House of Uniforms and Lands’ End.

GENERAL UNIFORM INFORMATION

FOR BOTH GIRLS AND BOYS

ALLOWED:

- Plain navy blue, red or white sweaters or sweater vests may be worn over the uniform shirt.
- St. Anne’s navy blue or red sweatshirts may be worn over the uniform shirt.
- Tennis shoes with shoe laces or Velcro for every day wear. Shoes with laces must be tied. (NOTE: Besides a pair of shoes for everyday wear, each student must have a pair of tennis shoes with non-skid soles which are to be reserved **ONLY** for P.E. class. Please do NOT purchase Pro Spirit shoes from Target because they mark the floor.)
- Tights may be worn. They must be white, red or navy blue.
- **Socks must be worn.** They must be white, red or navy blue.

NOT ALLOWED:

- Decorative belts including scarves, ropes, or chains.
- Hoodies.
- Anything made of fleece or sweatshirt material.
- Sweaters or sweatshirts worn around the waist.
- Crocs, flip-flops, Heelies/Wheelies, or slipper type footwear.
- Inappropriate or excessive jewelry. This includes beads, heavy chains, dog collars and items that are potentially dangerous.
Note: earrings may be worn in ears only (not in eyebrows, nose, mouth, lip, etc.)
- Inappropriate or heavy makeup.
- Inappropriate hair coloring and styling.
- Hats, caps, or scarves.

NOTE: The school administration reserves the right to determine what is appropriate and inappropriate.

GIRLS IN GRADES 1-6

- Navy blue* pants. (Cargo type pants, including pants with outside pockets, are allowed. However, pants must be plain; no racing stripes down the leg. Pants must be straight-legged. Pants must be of corduroy or cotton/twill material.)
- Navy blue* Capri pants. Capri pants must cover the knee.
- Navy blue* shorts.* May be worn during the months of August, September, October, April, May and June.
- **LENGTH OF SHORTS: Must be knee length, which means to the top of the knee cap. Nothing shorter is allowed.**
- NOT ALLOWED: knits, sweatpants, denim, spandex or leggings.
- * **Navy blue material swatches are available in the school office. Be sure any pants or shorts that are worn as part of the uniform match with the swatch.**
- Hamilton plaid jumper for Grades 1-5.
- Hamilton plaid culottes for Grades 1-6.
- Hamilton plaid skirts for Grades 5 & 6.
- **LENGTH OF JUMPERS, CULOTTES, AND SKIRTS: Must be knee length, which means to the top of the knee cap. Nothing shorter is allowed.**
- White collared polo shirt with two or three buttons, long or short sleeved. Shirt may either be plain with NO logo or with SA logo.
- Red and navy blue collared polo shirt with SA logo.
- White oxford shirt, long or short sleeved. Shirt may either be plain with NO logo or with SA logo
- White turtle neck or mock turtle neck shirt, long or short sleeved.
- BE SURE THAT SHIRTS ARE LONG ENOUGH TO BE TUCKED IN. SHIRTS ARE TO STAY TUCKED IN ALL DAY.
- NOT ALLOWED: cap sleeves; logos of any kind on tops unless the SA logo shirts are purchased.
- NOT ALLOWED: shirts like Aeropostales. For the purpose of our uniform code, camisoles are considered undergarments. Therefore, camisoles, if worn, may not be visible.

BOYS IN GRADES 1-6

- Navy blue* pants. Cargo type pants, including pants with outside pockets, are allowed. However, pants must be plain; no racing stripes down the leg. Pants must be straight-legged. Pants must be of corduroy or cotton/twill material.
- Navy blue* shorts. May be worn during the months of August, September, October, April, May and June.
- NOT ALLOWED: sagging pants.
- NOT ALLOWED: grossly oversized pants or shorts.
- * **Navy blue material swatches are available in the school office. Be sure any pants or shorts that are worn as part of the uniform match with the swatch.**
- White collared polo shirt with two or three buttons, long or short sleeved. Shirt may either be plain with NO logo or with SA logo.
- Red and navy blue collared polo shirt with SA logo.
- White oxford shirt, long or short sleeved. Shirt may either be plain with NO logo or with SA logo.
- White turtle neck or mock turtle neck shirt, long or short sleeved.
- BE SURE THAT SHIRTS ARE LONG ENOUGH TO BE TUCKED IN. SHIRTS ARE TO BE TUCKED IN ALL DAY.
- NOT ALLOWED: logos of any kind on tops unless the SA logo shirts are purchased.

GIRLS IN GRADES 7 & 8

- Navy blue or khaki* pants. (Cargo type pants, including pants with outside pockets, are allowed. However, pants must be plain; no racing stripes down the leg. Pants must be straight-legged. Pants must be of corduroy or cotton/twill material.)
 - Navy blue or khaki* Capri pants. Capri pants must cover the knee.
 - Navy blue or khaki* shorts. May be worn during the months of August, September, October, April, May and June.
 - **LENGTH OF SHORTS: Must be knee length, which means to the top of the knee cap. Nothing shorter is allowed.**
 - NOT ALLOWED: knits, sweatpants, denim, spandex or leggings.
- * **Navy blue and Khaki material swatches are available in the school office. Be sure any pants or shorts that are worn as part of the uniform match with the swatch.**

- Hamilton plaid skirts and culottes.
- **LENGTH OF SKIRTS AND CULOTTES: Must be knee length, which means to the top of the knee cap. Nothing shorter is allowed.**
- White collared polo shirt with two or three buttons, long or short sleeved. Shirt may either be plain with NO logo or with SA logo.
- Red and navy blue collared polo shirt with SA logo.
- White oxford shirt, long or short sleeved. Shirt may either be plain with NO logo or with SA logo.
- White turtle neck or mock turtle neck shirt, long or short sleeved.
- BE SURE THAT SHIRTS ARE LONG ENOUGH TO BE TUCKED IN. SHIRTS ARE TO BE TUCKED IN ALL DAY.
- NOT ALLOWED: cap sleeves or logos of any kind on tops unless the SA logo shirts are purchased.
- NOT ALLOWED: shirts like Aeropostales. For the purpose of our uniform code, camisoles are considered undergarments. Therefore, camisoles, if worn, may not be visible.

BOYS IN GRADES 7 & 8

- Navy blue or khaki* pants. Cargo type pants, including pants with outside pockets, are allowed. However, pants must be plain; no racing stripes down the leg. Pants must be straight-legged. Pants must be of corduroy or cotton/twill material.
 - Navy blue or khaki* shorts. May be worn during the months of August, September, October, April, May and June.
 - NOT ALLOWED: sagging or low rise waists.
- * **Navy blue and khaki material swatches are available in the school office. Color of pants and shorts MUST match the swatches.**
- White collared polo shirt with two or three buttons, long or short sleeved. Shirt may either be plain with NO logo or with SA logo.
 - Red and navy blue collared polo shirt with SA logo.
 - White oxford shirt, long or short sleeved. Shirt may either be plain with NO logo or with SA logo.
 - White turtle neck or mock turtle neck shirt, long or short sleeved.
 - BE SURE THAT SHIRTS ARE LONG ENOUGH TO BE TUCKED IN. SHIRTS ARE TO BE TUCKED IN ALL DAY.
 - NOT ALLOWED: logos of any kind on tops unless the SA logo shirts are purchased.

POLICIES FOR OUT-OF-UNIFORM DAYS

OUT-OF-UNIFORM DAYS

Students may only use **ONE** out of uniform pass in one school week. All students with an out-of-uniform pass must bring it to the school and present it to the homeroom teacher.

There are a number of out-of-uniform days throughout the school year. The school administration reserves the right to provide something for students to wear when students are dressed inappropriately/immodestly for out-of-uniform days.

DRESS-UP DAYS

- NOT ALLOWED: shorts, jeans, sweat pants, t-shirts, sweatshirts.

ALL OTHER OUT-OF-UNIFORM DAYS

- ALLOWED FOR GIRLS & BOYS: jeans provided they are not ripped or torn.
- ALLOWED FOR GIRLS & BOYS: shorts.
 - Girls may not wear short shorts. The length of shorts on out-of-uniform days must be the same as uniform shorts which is knee length which means at the top of the knee cap.
 - The length of boys' shorts may be no longer than mid-calf. NO sagging is allowed.
- ALLOWED FOR GIRLS: capris, skirts/skorts. The length of girls' skirts/skorts on out-of-uniform days must be the same as uniform shorts which is knee length which means at the top of the knee cap.
- ALLOWED FOR GIRLS & BOYS: sweatshirts and t-shirts provided that they have **NO** inappropriate/obscene/drug/alcohol related sayings or pictures.
- ALLOWED FOR GIRLS: sleeveless tops & camisoles under other tops.
- NOT ALLOWED FOR GIRLS: spaghetti strap tops, midriff tops, tube tops, & half-shirts. Stomach and back must be completely covered.
- NOT ALLOWED FOR BOYS: muscle shirts, sleeveless shirts, or half shirts.
- NOT ALLOWED FOR BOYS OR GIRLS: pajama style and/or flannel pants, basketball/athletic shorts, sweat pants, Under Armour shirts.
- ALLOWED: flip-flops and crocs.
- NOT ALLOWED: Heelies/Wheelies
- OPTIONAL: Socks.

SCOUTS

Students who are in Scouts may wear their Scout uniforms to school on Scout meeting days.

CHARITABLE WALKS/RACES

Students who participate in a walk or race for a charitable cause may be out of uniform the following school day if they wear the t-shirt or sweatshirt from the event. Students should get a permission form from the office on that day.

JEWELRY, MAKE-UP & HAIR

- Inappropriate or excessive jewelry. This includes beads, heavy chains, dog collars and items that are potentially dangerous.
Note: earrings may be worn in ears only (not in eyebrows, nose, mouth, lip, etc.)
- Inappropriate or heavy makeup.
- Inappropriate hair coloring and styling.
- Hats, caps, or scarves.
