EARN TUITION CREDIT BY PURCHASING RELOADABLE

KING SOOPERS CARDS!!

As in the past, each family who purchases King Soopers gift cards will have the 5% reward credited to their individual tuition account. However, for your convenience, starting this 2011-2012 school year, our King Soopers Reward Cards will be reloadable. This means that you only need to purchase one card for \$100 from our school office and reload (add value to it) as needed. **Cards must be purchased from our school office.** A card purchased in a store cannot be linked to our school/your tuition.

As in the past, purchases made with your reloadable card will apply the 5% credit to your tuition account for 2011-2012 thru April 30, 2012. Your tuition credit will be deducted from your May, 2012 tuition payment. If you have earned more money than the balance of your May, 2012 tuition payment, a tuition refund check will be issued to you. Purchases made starting May 1, 2012 will apply the 5% credit to your tuition account for the 2012-2013 school year.

Remember that you can buy gift cards for other family members, friends, and neighbors. When you purchase these cards from our school office, it will be noted that purchases made on those specific cards will earn the 5% credit towards your tuition account.

Cards can be used to purchase gas and prescriptions as well as groceries.

Cards can be purchased from our school office during regular school hours starting Wednesday, August 24.

Here is some important information regarding the reloadable cards:

- It is important to continually reload individual cards; do not throw them away.
- Cards with a zero balance for 90 days will become inactive. A new card will need to be purchased from our school office.
- The cards may be reloaded at the register or at the Customer Service Desk in any amount up to \$500.
- When a card is reloaded it must be a SEPARATE TRANSACTION PRIOR TO YOUR GROCERIES BEING SCANNED.
- King Soopers is not responsible for the card value if a card is lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed. In those cases, a new card will need to be purchased from our school office.
- There are 4 ways to obtain the balance on your gift card. The balance will be printed on the bottom of your cash register receipt; visit www.gcbalance.com; call 866-822-6252; or your cashier can check your balance.
