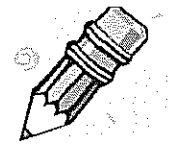
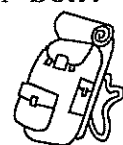




GRADE ONE SUPPLY LIST
2010-2011



- ❖ 1 red pen for correcting Label with name.
- ❖ 2 **thin**, black, dry erase markers
- ❖ 5 **strong pocket folders** with pockets at the bottom, not on the side. Label with child's name on the FRONT. Please **do not** buy ones with center prongs, and make sure that the folders are sturdy.
- ❖ 3 wide ruled composition books (9.75 x 7.5 in./24.7 x 19.0cm) Label with name on the front cover.
- ❖ 1 box of regular crayons (no more than 24 count) Label with name.
- ❖ 1 box of large or jumbo crayons DO NOT LABEL.
- ❖ 1 child size "Fiskar-type" pointed scissors Label with name.
- ❖ 8 glue sticks DO NOT LABEL.
- ❖ 1 pearl pink eraser Label with name.
- ❖ 1 package of pencil top cap erasers DO NOT LABEL.
- ❖ 1 box each of Crayola Classic Colors Fine Line and Broad Line Markers (8 count each) Label with name on each marker.
- ❖ 1 black Permanent Marker
- ❖ 1 pencil box without handles (This must be able to fit in desk - a box that is 8" X 5" is a good size.)
- ❖ 2 rolls of paper towels
- ❖ 1 box of Kleenex (250 count)
- ❖ 3 baby wipes (80 count each) in rectangular/square containers. Please **do not** purchase the round containers.
- ❖ \$25.00 fee for Art Please enclose in an envelope labeled with name.
- ❖ 1 pair tennis shoes to be worn for P.E. class only. No black marking soles, no slip-ons and no high tops. Shoes are to be labeled with the student's name. These shoes are to stay at school.
- ❖ 1 backpack large enough to hold folder, books, and lunch box.

GRADE 5 SUPPLY LIST 2010-2011

All 5th grade students are expected to have 12 wooden pencils, 4 erasable blue or black ballpoint pens (no gel pens), and 5 red pens in each class everyday. Additional necessary supplies are as follows:

- 1 Pencil eraser
- 1 24-count box of crayons
- 1 Package of inexpensive colored pencils
- 2 Packages of water color markers: 1 broad tip and 1 fine tip
- 2 Highlighter pens
- 2* Dry erase markers, blue or black
- 1 Pencil bag
- 2* 4 oz. bottle **white** (no glitter or colors) multi-purpose glue
- 1 Scissors (sharp, suitable for sewing and LABELED with student's name)
- 1* Packages of wide-lined loose-leaf paper
- 5 Single subject, wide-lined spiral notebooks (not the wireless kind)
- 1 Three-pronged pocket folders
- 5 Pocket folders without prongs
- 1 12-inch ruler marked in centimeters and inches
- 1 Inexpensive compass
- 1 **STURDY** plastic **dishpan** sized tub for books and supplies (**Please, do not send oversized tubs.**)
- 3* Rolls of paper towels
- 2* Boxes of facial tissues

- * 12 Pencils – **NOT** mechanical pencils
 - 4 blue or black pens with **erasable** ink (**Gel pens are not acceptable.**)
 - 4 red ballpoint pens, for correcting. Must have one at all times.
 - 1 pkg. 12-24 inexpensive colored pencils
 - 1 pkg. fine-line markers
 - 1 highlighting marker
 - 2 combination metric/standard 12" rulers (plastic preferred) 1 @ school, 1 @ home
 - 1 scissors (to fit in pencil bag)
 - 1 pkg. 3-hole punched, loose-leaf paper, to start the year – more when needed
 - 1 3 subject (college ruled) spiral notebook – for Mrs. Clements's classes(**NOT perforated sheets**)
 - 1 3 subject (college ruled) spiral notebook – for Mr. Halbmaier's classes
 - 1 single subject spiral notebook - (for Spanish, wide ruled – labeled with name)
 - 1 composition book (wide ruled)
 - 1 plastic X-Doc-It file with 10-12 slots

 - 1 8 tab package of dividers for a binder




